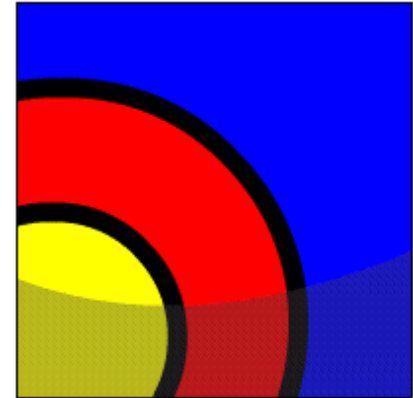

What Will I Learn?

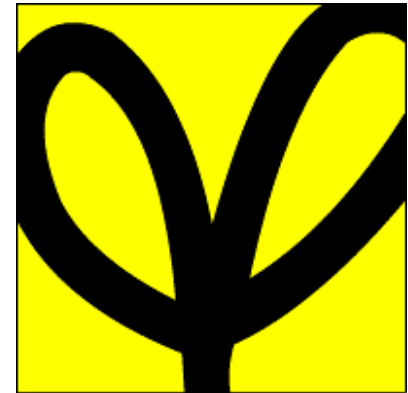
In this lesson, you will learn to:

Why Learn It?

Sports teams hold regular practice sessions, theater companies have rehearsals before a show, and musicians practice regularly on their instruments. The stellar performances you see at the game, the show, or the concert would not be possible without practice.



Think about the first time you solved a math problem, played a video game, or learned to swim. Were you very good at it? What did you do to get better? Practice!

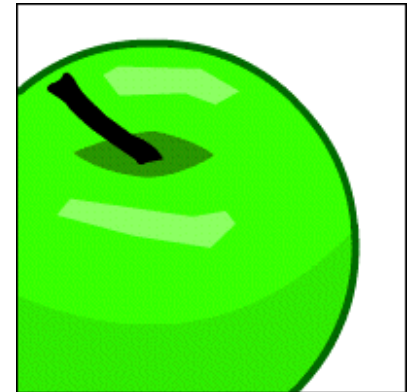
This lesson gives you a chance to practice professional skills that you will need in the business world, in a more familiar school environment.

Classroom Activity: Presentation Rehearsal

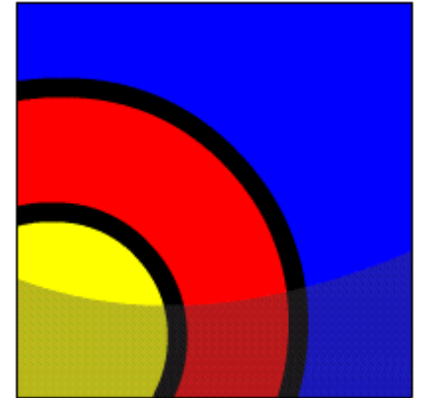
Review your presentation with your group.
