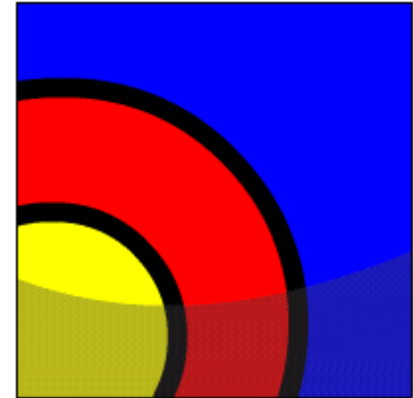

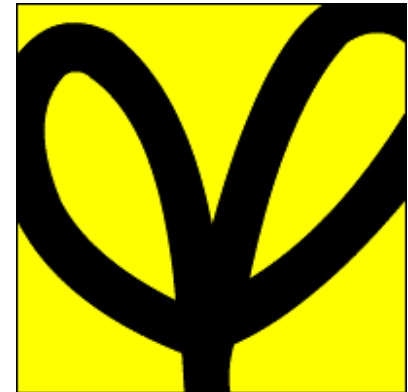


Why Learn It?

If you take the time to learn another language, being finally able to converse in that language should give you great satisfaction.

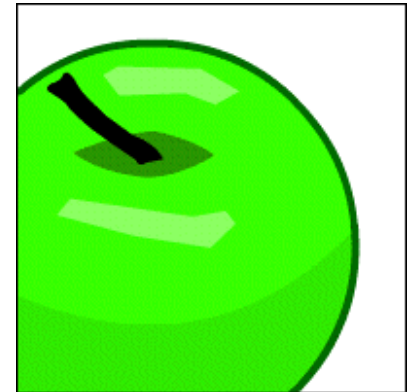
You should be similarly confident about what you've achieved in this course. The skills you have learned and practiced will be useful in any career that you pursue.

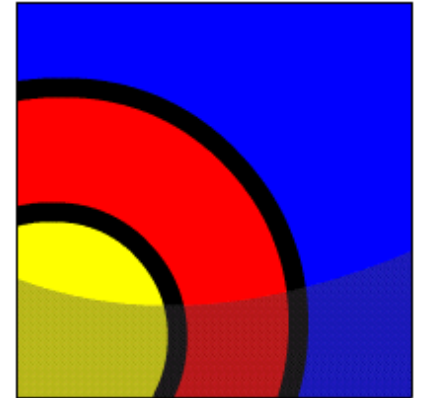
